### faith promise giving update

Since our initial World Missions Conference in 1979, the World Missions budget has been provided by the Lord over and above the general budget through **Faith Promise** giving.



The Faith Promise is a generous offering that members of the fellowship give as God speaks to their hearts. The promise to give is based upon the faith to receive. It is not a promise to give something you already have, but faith to promise to give something you don't have. A Faith Promise is simply trusting the Lord for the ability to give an amount of money which you are not able to give in order that you might use it specifically for Christ's global cause.

Faith Promise giving is the primary way our church directly supports our 81 Faith Promise missionaries. Your undesignated Faith Promise gifts are used to help support international, national, and local missions through these career missionary families.

Our FBA Global Missions policy states that the congregation will be made aware of any shortage in our Faith Promise giving.





## fba global missions

#### God is working through your prayers and generosity around the world TODAY!

• This missionary is a member of France Mission, a leading French church-planting movement which has 60 church plants underway at various stages of completion.

• This Christian organization has a mission to serve the Church in Lebanon and the Arab world through spiritual, social, and educational development.

• This ministry provides after-school mentoring and English as a Second Language (ESL) classes. They evangelize by hosting outreach events such as sports camps, music camps, Backyard Bible Clubs, and holiday celebrations within the apartment complexes where they minister, taking the church to the people.

· Another ministry team conducts training for a mission hospital network of over 5,000 national workers.

· A missionary riverboat takes doctors, nurses and evangelists through the Amazon jungle, broadcasting in three languages, to remote villages, and a training center to teach Christian indigenous men and women how to reach the remaining people groups in the Amazon.

• This team trains leaders as they direct a discipleship movement in the region by investing in the lives of a few leaders and growing them to maturity - the few can impact the many.

- A leader of teams in three regions of Asia where over 3,000 Ethnos360 missionaries serve, provides consulting services during all stages of the church-planting process.
- With a heart for refugees, they planted a church to share the Gospel with the local refugee community, hosts events to minister to the people of Greece, and educate believers.
- This missionary helped develop a program for recording cultural observations and analyses, and for developing a dictionary to help translators in their work.
