



Guidelines for Reopening | Phase Two

State and local Guidance

- Leadership, FBA Security Team, and FBA Medical Advisory Team will monitor state and local guidance concerning COVID-19 infection rates, reopening best practices, and general recommendations.
- All FBA guidelines are fluid and may be adjusted at any time based on current COVID-19 infection rates in our community.

Reopening Schedule

- 8:45 a.m. | In-person only
- 10:30 a.m. | In-person & Livestream Experience
 - Family ministries are open during this hour only.
- 12:15 p.m. | In-person only

Sunday Morning Guidelines

- Only attend one worship service, allowing space for others.
- Seating will be self-guided with social distancing in mind.
- Ushers will be available to assist as needed.
- Masks are encouraged at all times upon entering the building and throughout the worship services.
- Bring your own Bible, pen, and paper for use during the service. Take everything with you when you leave.
- Do not stop to greet or fellowship with others when entering or exiting the building.
- Place offering in the no-contact offering box upon entrance or exit.
- Exit the building in a timely manner to allow for cleaning of the area for the next service.

General Safety Guidelines

- Masks are encouraged to be worn at all times, fully covering the nose and mouth.
 - (Exception: Preschoolers age infant through 4 years old)
- Maintain six (6) feet of social distancing when possible.
- Refrain from hugging and/or shaking hands.
- Utilize hand sanitizing stations that are available at all entrances.
- Wash your hands (20 seconds) before exiting the restroom.
- Do not attend in person if you are:
 - High risk as defined by the CDC
 - Too young to adhere to or understand social distancing safe practices
 - Sick or have had close contact with a person with COVID-19

Facilities Plan

- The facility will be deep-cleaned before in-person services.
- Worship Center will be sanitized before, between, and after services.
- No offering plate will be passed. Offering boxes are strategically placed at entrances/exits.
- No bulletin, visitor card, pens or papers will be distributed or available in the Worship Center. Visitors will be directed to the visitor stations located near the main entrance/exit.
- The FBA Bookstore is open with safety protocols in place.
- The Media Library will remain closed.

Communication Plan

- The current reopening plan will be posted on fba.org.
- General Safety Guidelines and Sunday Morning Guidelines will be posted on fba.org.
- Georgia O.C.G.A. 51-16-3 Ordinance and general safety guidelines will be displayed with signage at all main entrances/exits.
- Sunday morning guidelines will be reinforced by the platform leadership.

Security Plan

- The FBA Security Team will be on standby to assist as needed.

Infection Response Plan

- If an individual displays symptoms of COVID-19 during hours of worship, the FBA Paramedic Team will be notified.
 - The individual will be separated from the worship experience, temperature will be taken, personal information gathered, and the individual will be asked to leave the property and schedule a COVID-19 test.
 - The FBA Paramedic on duty will determine if further medical assistance is needed.
 - The individual will be asked to communicate with the church regarding the results of the COVID test. Once results are received, an additional response will be assessed as needed.
- Individuals with possible exposure to COVID-19 will be advised to stay home and self-monitor for symptoms and follow CDC guidance if symptoms develop.
