

## 1 GARY & PENNY SEITHEL United World Mission, England

These families, near Rakai, were overjoyed with the provision of beans, maize flour and soap to sustain them during this difficult time. The pathology report showed the lymphoma as a slow-growing type that could spread, but the doctor feels that it was mostly confined to the spleen (which was completely removed).
